Kasper J. Krzemiński is partner in the Litigation & Arbitration practice group of NautaDutilh (the Netherlands). He specializes in the resolution of commercial and contractual disputes. Finance, a specialized arbitration institution for the resolution of complex financial disputes. Kasper obtained his LL.M. degree from New York University School of Law in 2006. He joined NautaDutilh in the same year.
